Under the warm sunshine in the spacious green of Gold Coast Hotel, we go Africa! Dressed in African costumes and linked by the unique African drumming beat, you will be amazed by the magic of the rhythms which breaks the barriers between different people. Through dancing, singing, drumming and various activities, we will lead you explore and treasure other's talents, value team goals, motivate others, communicate effectively with teammates, and open your mind to learn new things. Using African rhythms as a metaphor, the 'Best Show' will mark the end of the day with everyone sharing the same goal and striving for the best performance in an African way. You will bring home not only fun and memorable moments, but lifetime skills on team dynamics and management.

## Objectives

The workshop uses African activities as a training metaphor to let participants to

- 1) have fun
- 2) experience team rhythm and resonance
- 3) be motivated by value incentives for driving excellence
- 4) foster effective communication and co-operation
- 5) develop the sense of 'One Company'

## Why choose “One Best Show”

### Experiential learning methodology

Experiential learning emphasizes learning from reflection of selected activities by participants' active participation in sharing their ideas and points of view. The learning process is dynamic and bilateral.

### African activities as an effective metaphor

To create extraordinary experience, African drumming, dancing, singing and make-ups are integrated into this programme. With “Go Africa” as the theme, these activities will create strong metaphor to enable participants to visualize the learning objectives easily, to create a stronger correlation of the activities with the real working life and to bring far-reaching effect.

### Non-verbal training tools – African Drumming


Musical rhythms create magic! When you are on the beat, you can feel everyone is connected by sharing the same goals and values. African drumming is known for its strong rhythms and we will use it as a distinctive media to connect the participants in their experience of all the hard-to-explained intangible concepts in a team – the team rhythm, the spirit of one team, the power of standardization and the team satisfaction. It will be an amazing experience without involving one single word from anybody in the session.

### Small groups and Whole team

While all participants may be joined together as one team to grasp the concept of “One Company”, they may also be divided into small groups, with an average size of approximately 15 people, to facilitate effective sharing and discussion during various sessions

### Debriefing with simple and precise concept


